About Lansdowne



Lansdowne Children's Centre

Lansdowne Children's Centre provides child development resources, supports and services for infants, children, and youth facing **communication**, **developmental and physical special needs and/or challenges**, and their families.

Lansdowne serves the region of Grand Erie, including Brantford, Brant, Haldimand and Norfolk counties, Six Nations of the Grand River, and Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation, with sites in Brantford, Caledonia, Dunnville and Simcoe.

Since 1974, Lansdowne has delivered family-centred care, rehabilitation, respite, and recreation programs. Many client journeys begin with a referral in their early years and continue to access Lansdowne resources up to their adult transition years (approx. 19 years old). As of March 2024, Lansdowne serves over 3,600 children and youth, and their families, with over 2,400 additional children awaiting service or assessment.
