Board Member Eligibility

- Members (and therefore, applicants) must be at least 18 years of age.
- Applicants must undergo background checks [police and Child & Family Services of Grand Erie]

Connection with Lansdowne Children's Centre as a past client, client family or caregiver is beneficial, but is not a prerequisite for consideration.

The Board of Directors for Lansdowne Children's Centre has a maximum of 16 voting members, and an Ex-Officio appointed Medical Director.

Your Board Commitment

- Board members are required to attend monthly meetings, typically during midday.
- The Board meets as a united group on alternating months.
- Committees meet as sub-groups on alternate months and as scheduled.
- Board membership requires participation on a Committee.
- One Board member also serves as a liaison to Lansdowne Children's Centre Foundation Board
- Participation and attendance at Centre and community functions, including Lansdowne Foundation events, is valued but not mandatory.
